Yacht Club to host wine and jazz festival

The Solano Yacht Club, on the water in the Suisun City Marina, will host a wine tasting and jazz festival on Sept. 19.

There will be eight wineries and vintners from Suisun Valley offering a tasting of their award-winning wines.
